#### 1. JOSEPH'S CIRCUMSTANCES

### \* <u>Rejected</u> at home

"(His brothers) hated him so much they wouldn't speak to him in a friendly manner." Genesis 37:4 (GN)

<sup>21</sup> . . . "Let's not kill him," he said. <sup>22</sup> "Just throw him into this well in the wilderness, . . . Genesis 37:21-22 (TEV)

### \* HARASSMENT at work

"After a while his master's wife began to desire Joseph and asked him to go to bed with her. He refused. . . But she asked <u>day after day</u>. . ." Genesis 39:7+10 (GN)

"That Hebrew slave tried to rape me!" Genesis 37:17 (LB)

# \* <u>Forgotten in prison.</u>

"... Please be kind enough to mention me to the king and help me get out of this prison... But the wine steward never gave Joseph another thought -- he <u>forgot</u> <u>all about him</u>." Genesis 40:14+23

#### 2. JOSEPH'S CHARACTER

## \* Fulfill my <u>RESPONSIBILITIES</u>

<sup>6</sup> So Potiphar gave Joseph the <u>complete administrative responsibility</u> over everything he owned. He hadn't a worry in the world with Joseph there, . . . Genesis 39:6 (TLB)

"The jailer soon handed over the <u>entire prison administration</u> to Joseph . . . and had no more worries after that, for Joseph took care of everything. . . " Genesis 39:22-23 (LB)

"Pharaoh said, `Who could do a <u>better job</u> than Joseph? For he is a man who is obviously filled with the Spirit of God." Genesis 41:38 (LB)

"The person who is <u>faithful</u> in the <u>little</u> things will be faithful in <u>big</u> things, and the one who cheats in the little things will cheat in big things too." Luke 16:10 (Ph)

# \* Maintain my <u>INTEGRITY</u>

"And though she spoke to Joseph <u>day after day, he refused to go to bed with her</u> or even be with her." Genesis 39:10 (NIV)

". . . <u>My master trusts me</u> with everything in this entire household . . . How can I do such a wicked thing as this? It would be a <u>great sin against God!</u>" Genesis 39:8-9 (LB)

### \* Trust GOD'S SOVEREIGNTY
