## > THE SCARCITY CYCLE STARTS IN THE MIND NOT IN THE WALLET.

For as he thinks in his heart, so is he... Proverbs 23:7 NKJV

### **Experiencing God's Abundance**

#### 1) GOD MULTIPLIES WHAT IS <u>BLESSED</u>.

They sat down in groups of hundreds and of fifties. <sup>41</sup> And He took the five loaves and the two fish, and looking up toward heaven, He

#### 2) GOD MULTIPLIES WHAT IS GIVEN AWAY.

...[Jesus] gave thanks and broke the loaves. Then he gave them to the disciples, and the disciples gave them to the people.

Matthew 14:19 NIV
